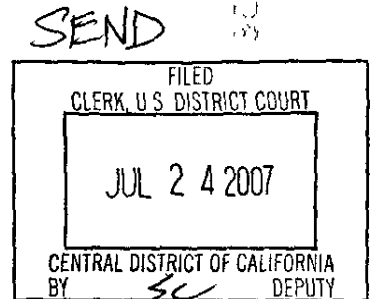

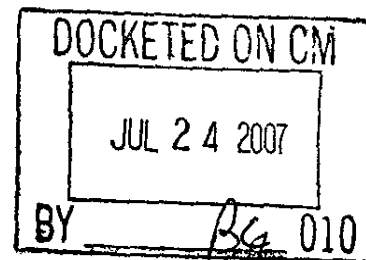

23 WHEREAS on June 12, 2007 the Court issued a Temporary Restraining
24 Order ("TRO") and Order to Show Cause Re Preliminary Injunction (the "OSC");

25 WHEREAS the Order sets forth specific dates for the expiration of the TRO
26 and for the briefing schedule and hearing on the OSC;

27 WHEREAS recently retained counsel for defendant Liao has requested
28 additional time to familiarize himself with the facts and issues raised by this action;

2 WHEREAS the parties consent to all of the terms set forth below, including
3 the extension of the TRO:

4 **STIPULATION**

5 The Securities and Exchange Commission, defendant Liao, and the
6 corporate and relief defendants through Temporary Receiver Robb Evans &
7 Associates, LLC, through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate as follows and
8 agree that the Court may immediately issue an order consistent with this
9 Stipulation and Proposed Order:

10 At 10:00 a.m. on August 13, 2007, the defendants shall appear before the
11 Honorable Christina A. Snyder, Judge of the United States District Court for the
12 Central District of California, to show cause, if there be any, why a preliminary
13 injunction should not be granted and a permanent receiver not appointed in
14 accordance with the prayer for relief contained in the Commission's Complaint.

15 Any declarations, affidavits, points and authorities, or other submissions in
16 support of, or in opposition to, the issuance of such an Order shall be filed with the
17 Court and delivered to opposing counsel no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 2, 2007.

18 Any reply papers shall be filed with the Court and delivered to opposing
19 counsel no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 6, 2007.

20 The TRO shall be extended and shall expire at 10:00 a.m. on August 14,
21 2007, unless, for good cause shown, it is extended or unless the parties against
22 whom it is directed consent that it may be extended for a longer period.


