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25 The matter of the Motion for Order (1) Approving Receiver's Report of  
26 Activities; (2) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's and  
27 Professionals' Fees and Expenses for the Period from September 1, 2008 Through  
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1 May 31, 2009; and (3) Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-7 Pertaining to Notice  
2 to Creditors (“Motion”) filed by Robb Evans & Associates LLC, the permanent  
3 receiver (“Receiver”) over AOB Commerce, Inc. and AOB Asia Fund I, LLC and  
4 Relief Defendants AOB Management, Inc., AOB Media, Inc., AOB Transportation,  
5 Inc. and AOB Vacations, Inc., and their subsidiaries and affiliates (“Receivership  
6 Entities”) came on regularly for hearing at the above-referenced date, time and  
7 place before the Honorable Christina A. Snyder, United States District Judge  
8 presiding. Gary Owen Caris of McKenna Long & Aldridge LLP appeared on  
9 behalf of the Receiver, and other appearances, if any, were made as noted in the  
10 record. There were no other appearances despite due and proper notice. The Court  
11 having read and considered the Motion and all supporting papers, and opposition to  
12 the Motion, if any, and good cause appearing therefor,

13 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 14 1. The Motion is granted in its entirety;  
15 2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

16 A. The Report of Receiver’s Activities covering the period of February 1,  
17 2008 through June 30, 2009, filed with the Court on July 30, 2009, is hereby  
18 approved and the Court hereby confirms all activities of the Receiver as described  
19 therein;

20 B. The fees and expenses of the Receiver for the period from September  
21 1, 2008 through May 31, 2008, comprised of fees of the Receiver and its staff of  
22 \$67,000.26 and Receiver’s costs of \$16,228.63, and fees of \$39,401.50 and costs of  
23 \$2,226.99 incurred by the Receiver’s counsel, for a total sum of \$124,857.38, are  
24 hereby approved and payment thereof is hereby authorized to be made from  
25 receivership funds; and

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C. The notice of the Motion provided by the Receiver is hereby deemed sufficient under the circumstances, and the Receiver is relieved of the obligation to provide notice of the Motion under Local Rule 66-7.
