3 Through January 31, 2008; (2) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver’s
4 and Professionals’ Fees and Expenses for the Period from September 1, 2007
5 Through February 29, 2008; and (3) Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-7
6 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors is made by and among plaintiff Securities and
7 Exchange Commission, defendant Terchi Liao aka Nelson Liao, and Robb Evans &
8 Associates LLC, the permanent receiver (“Receiver”) over AOB Commerce, Inc.
9 and AOB Asia Fund I, LLC and Relief Defendants AOB Management, Inc., AOB
10 Media, Inc., AOB Transportation, Inc. and AOB Vacations, Inc., and their
11 subsidiaries and affiliates, in reference to the following:

12 A. The Receiver filed its Motion for Order (1) Approving Report of
13 Receiver’s Activities for the Period from July 24, 2007 Through January 31, 2008;
14 (2) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver’s and Professionals’ Fees and
15 Expenses for the Period from September 1, 2007 Through February 29, 2008; and
16 (3) Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-7 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors
17 (“Motion”) on May 16, 2008.

18 B. On May 23, 2008, counsel for plaintiff Securities and Exchange
19 Commission (“SEC”) requested that the Receiver agree to continue the hearing on
20 the Motion for three weeks to June 30, 2008 to provide the SEC sufficient time to
21 review the Motion and supporting papers and prepare a response, if any, to the
22 relief sought. No response to the Motion has been filed by any other party or
23 creditor. No appearance in the action has been made by any defendant other than
24 defendant Terchi Liao aka Nelson Liao.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the parties hereto stipulate and
26 agree that the hearing on the Motion should be continued for a period of three
27 weeks to June 30, 2008, that the SEC’s deadline for responding to the Motion
28 should be extended to June 16, 2008 in accordance with the Local Rules, and that

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the parties request that the Court approve this request for a continuance and enter the proposed order lodged concurrently herewith.
