
IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Motion and the relief sought therein is granted;
2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Temporary Receiver’s Interim Restricted Operations Proposal submitted as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of M. Val Miller filed in support of the Motion is approved;
3. In accordance with the Interim Restricted Operations Proposal, the Temporary Receiver is authorized to cease the Business Opportunities operations of the Receivership Defendants;

4. In accordance with the Interim Restricted Operations Proposal, the Temporary Receiver authorized (a) to immediately cease operation of the business of the Receivership Defendants without further notice or order of the Court if the Temporary Receiver determines the business cannot be operated profitably, and (b) to seek other relief from the Court and/or instructions regarding the operation of the business based on additional information and events hereafter determined by the Temporary Receiver to warrant such relief.
