**NOTICE TO CONSUMERS**

December 19, 2008

On December 2, 2008 the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts appointed Robb Evans & Associates LLC as Receiver of Cambridge Credit Corp. and its related entities. A copy of the District Court's appointment order is posted at [www.robbevans.com/pdf/cambridgecorder04.pdf](http://www.robbevans.com/pdf/cambridgecorder04.pdf).

The company is now under the supervision of the United States District Court through the Receiver.

Since taking control of the company we are aware that some consumers' accounts were debited and that some consumers sent money orders to the company and corresponding payments were not made to all creditors. We have stopped that practice. Going forward, any debits to a consumer account or any money orders received will be processed and creditors will be paid.

It will take us considerable time to analyze and reconcile the thousands of transactions made by the company which occurred over many months or longer to determine exactly what caused this problem. In the meantime, the Court Order appointing the Receiver prohibits consumers from revoking transactions settled on or before December 9, 2008. All transactions which were settled on or before December 9, 2008 were initiated by the company on or before December 1, 2008 and are pre-receivership transactions.
