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 20 The Court, having read and considered the Ex Parte Motion for Instructions
 21 Regarding Production of Documents of the Receivership Defendants to Plaintiff
 22 and Contempt Defendants (the "Motion") filed by Receiver Robb Evans &
 23 Associates LLC ("Receiver"), the response of the FTC, and opposition to the
 24 Motion by Americas Law Group, Rodis Law Group, and defendant Bryan
 25 D' Antonio, and good cause being shown therefor, it is

26 ORDERED as follows:

- 27 1. The Motion is granted.

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1 2. The Receiver is authorized to grant the Plaintiff and all Contempt
2 Defendants, as that term is defined in the Preliminary Injunction Order issued June
3 22, 2009, prompt access to all client files of any of the Receivership Defendants, as
4 that term is defined in the Preliminary Injunction Order, and all other documents
5 and electronic records of all of the Receivership Defendants in the custody, control
6 and possession of the Receiver, by the Receiver allowing Plaintiff and all Contempt
7 Defendants (individually and collectively the "Parties") to inspect, inventory and
8 copy the documents and electronic records at the premises of the Receivership
9 Defendants at the expense of the Parties, except that the Receiver may
10 electronically transmit to the Parties, at the Parties' expense, copies of the
11 electronic records of the Receivership Defendants to their counsels' offices.

12 3. The Parties shall be required to comply with the terms of the
13 Protective Order issued by the Court concurrently with the issuance of this Order.
