**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY RECEIVER TO SELL AND/OR LIQUIDATE
THE ASSETS OF THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE**

1 Tree Company Inc., Arrowhead Tree Service, Inc., Arrowhead Tree Company, Inc., and M.J.
2 Equipment, LLC, (the "Businesses") pursuant to which Robb Evans & Associates LLC was
3 appointed as the Temporary Receiver over the properties and businesses of Richard Edward
4 Mowbray and Denise Lynn Mowbray including, but not limited to, the Businesses identified
5 above.

6 2. In open court on October 7, 2005, the Court considered an oral request from the
7 District Attorney for the County of Riverside, counsel Richard Edward Mowbray, counsel for
8 Denise Lynn Mowbray and the Temporary Receiver, that, based upon the current financial
9 condition of the Businesses, the Receiver be authorized to immediately commence negotiations for
10 the sale of the Businesses as a going concern, or, in the alternative, if the Temporary Receiver was
11 unable to effectuate the sale of the Businesses, either individually or collectively, to commence the
12 liquidation of the assets of the Businesses. The Court granted the parties' request and this Order is
13 intended to memorialize the Court's Order.

14 BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, AND FOR GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS
15 HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

16 1. The Temporary Receiver is hereby authorized to use its best efforts to sell the
17 Businesses, individually or collectively, as a going concern. The sale of said Businesses, either
18 individually or collectively, will be subject to final court approval.

19 2. In the event the Temporary Receiver is unable to effectuate the sale of the
20 Businesses, either individually or collectively, as going concerns, the Temporary Receiver may
21 immediately commence the orderly liquidation of the assets of said Businesses. No additional
22 court approval will be necessary of the liquidation of the Businesses' assets.

23 3. The proceeds from the sale of the Businesses and/or the liquidation of the
24 Businesses' assets shall be held by the receivership estate pending further order of Court.

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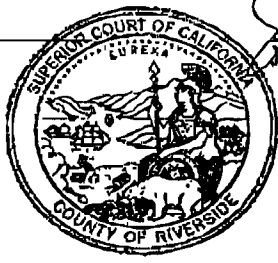
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4. The Temporary Receiver is hereby authorized to take any and all additional actions necessary, in its discretion and judgment, to effectuate the terms and provisions of this Order.
