6 arguments and contentions of counsel, and good cause appearing therefor,

7 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 8 1. The Motion and the relief sought therein is granted in its entirety;
9 2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the receivership fees
10 and expenses incurred for the period from September 1, 2008 through April 30,
11 2009 ("Twelfth Expense Period") as more particularly set forth in the Motion are
12 hereby approved and the Receiver is authorized to make payment of such fees and
13 expenses, including payment of the fees of the Receiver, the Receiver's deputies,
14 agents, staff and professionals and reimbursement of costs incurred during the
15 Twelfth Expense Period from the assets of the receivership estate.
