The Motion by Receiver for Order Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's Fees and Expenses [September 1, 2010 Through July 31, 2011] ("Motion") filed by the permanent receiver, Robb Evans ("Receiver") came on regularly for hearing at the above-referenced date, time and place before the Honorable Audrey B. Collins, Chief Judge of the United States District Court for

1 the Central District of California presiding. Gary Owen Caris of McKenna Long &
2 Aldridge LLP appeared on behalf of the Receiver, and Peter Del Greco appeared on
3 behalf of plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”). No other
4 appearances were made despite due and proper notice of the hearing. The Court,
5 having reviewed and considered the Motion and the pleadings and papers filed in
6 support thereof, and the Statement of Non-Opposition to the Motion filed by
7 plaintiff SEC, and no opposition having been filed, and having heard the arguments
8 of counsel, and good cause appearing therefor,

9 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 10 1. The Motion and the relief sought therein is granted in its entirety;
- 11 2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the receivership fees
12 and expenses incurred for the period from September 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011
13 (“Sixteenth Expense Period”) as more particularly set forth in the Motion are
14 hereby approved and the Receiver is authorized to make payment of such fees and
15 expenses, including payment of the fees of the Receiver, the Receiver’s deputies,
16 agents, and staff and the Receiver’s attorneys McKenna Long & Aldridge LLP, and
17 reimbursement of costs incurred by the Receiver and his attorneys during the
18 Sixteenth Expense Period, from the assets of the receivership estate.
