EXONERATING RECEIVER’S BOND**



The Court has considered the Motion and the Final Accounting of Receiver. Based on the Receiver’s Final Accounting, the Motion, and the entire record before the Court in this matter, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- (1) allowing, settling, and approving the Final Accounting;
- (2) approving and ratifying the activities of the Receiver in this matter,

- 1 (3) approving the Receiver's payment of the fees and expenses of the receivership;  
2 (4) authorizing the Receiver to shred all documents of the receivership Defendants;  
3 (5) discharging Robb Evans & Associates, LLC and its members, officers,  
4 employees, agents, attorneys and representatives, and relieving them from all duties,  
5 liabilities, and responsibilities with regard to this case or in connection with any and all  
6 property that is the subject of the receivership;  
7 (6) exonerating the Receiver's bond filed in connection with this matter, Bond No.  
8 443251, and  
9 (7) authorizing the Receiver to turn over to the Federal Trade Commission all  
10 funds remaining after the Receiver's payment of all outstanding fees, costs and expenses of  
11 the Receivership.
