**ORDER**

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, based upon: (a) the Final Report of the Receiver; (b) the judgments previously entered in favor of the Federal Trade Commission against each of the parties defendant in this cause; (c) the absence of any timely filed Objection; and (d) the entire record in this matter, that the Receiver has fully performed all of its duties under the various Orders entered in the cause and has accounted fully for all of the assets placed in Receivership to the point that nothing remains to be done except disbursing final compensation to the Receiver and its counsel; and


It further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the assets remaining under the control of the Receiver are insufficient to pay in full compensation for the Receiver and its counsel already approved by this Court and that the Receivership is unable to remit any proceeds of liquidation to parties injured the actions and omissions of Defendants;

It is hereby ORDERED ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Final Report of the Receiver is hereby accepted and approved by the Court.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Receiver's plan to pro-rate the remaining assets over the unpaid compensation owed to it and its counsel is approved and the Receiver is authorized to make such disbursements ten (10) days after the entry of this Order, provided that no Notice of Appeal is filed by any party having standing to do so.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that upon disbursement of the final expenses of the Receivership, the Receiver is, with the thanks of the Court, discharged of any further obligation in this matter with full acquittance, as is the surety for the Receiver.
