**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR  
ORDER APPROVING AND  
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF  
RECEIVER'S AND  
PROFESSIONAL'S FEES AND  
COSTS FROM INCEPTION OF THE  
RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE FROM  
JUNE 1, 2018 THROUGH  
SEPTEMBER 30, 2018**

The Court previously issued its Order re Motion for Order Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's and Professional's Fees and Costs From June 1, 2018 Through September 30, 2018 (Fee Order) which approved, with certain exceptions, the fees and costs sought for payment pursuant to the Motion. Having read and considered the Declaration of Gary Owen Caris in response to the Fee Order, having approved the suggested reductions to the fees sought in the Motion set forth in that declaration, and good cause appearing, it is

**ORDERED that:**

1. The following fees and costs incurred from June 1, 2018, through September 30, 2018 are approved and authorized to be paid from the assets in the

1 receivership estate:

2 A. The fees of the Receiver, the Receiver's members and staff of  
3 \$69,553.50 and Receiver's costs of \$6,375.50, for a total of \$75,929.00; and

4 B. The fees of the Receiver's counsel, Barnes & Thornburg LLP  
5 of \$211,197.60 and costs of \$5,848.08, for a total of \$217,045.68.

6 2. In the event DNE Associates obtains an order permitting it to be paid  
7 funds from the receivership estate which, after such payment, leaves the amount  
8 held by the Receiver below the amount approved and authorized to be paid from  
9 this Order, Plaintiff shall promptly pay to the Receiver the shortfall.

10 3. Notice of the Motion is deemed sufficient under Local Rule  
11 66-7 based on the service of the Motion on all parties and certain creditors of the  
12 estate, but not on the thousands of potential consumers, lenders, loan servicers, title  
13 insurers and other third parties who may have been defrauded by the Defendants.
