ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF FROM RESPONSE DEADLINES

On this day, came to be heard Defendants, Prolink Vision, S.R.L., Mohammad Souheil, 9896988 Canada Inc., and Charles Kharouf's Unopposed Motion for Continuance and Request for Relief from Response Deadlines

After consideration of the pleadings and evidence stated therein, it is the opinion of the Court that the Motion for Continuance is well taken and should be: Granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the Unopposed Motion for Continuance, ECF No. 14, is hereby Granted.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the Preliminary Injunction Hearing is rescheduled to September 3, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. and that the following deadlines have been extended as follows:

1. Movants' responsive pleadings to the Application for Injunction and Temporary Restraining Order shall be filed no later than seven (7) days prior to the scheduled hearing; Plaintiffs reply shall be filed no later than three (3) days prior to the scheduled hearing.
2. Movants' responses to Sections VI, XIV, XV, and XXI shall be produced on a rolling basis to be completed on or before August 27, 2019.
3. The obligation in section VII(C) regarding the transfer of assets to the territory of the United States is hereby suspended until further notice by this Court. The remaining obligations in Section VII shall be completed on a rolling basis to be completed on or before August 27, 2019.
4. Movants are provided twenty-eight (28) days from the date of service to respond to any additional expedited discovery propounded by Plaintiffs pursuant to Section XXII of the Temporary Restraining Order.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the Temporary Restraining Order granted in this case is extended with the consent of Prolink Vision, S.R.L., Mohammad Souheil, 9896988 Canada Inc., and Charles Kharouf to September 3, 2019, the date of the Preliminary Injunction Hearing.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that entry of this Order does not alter, affect or waive any defenses that Defendants may have to this Action and that all defenses are preserved.
