2 A. The fees of the Receiver, the Receiver's members and staff of  
3 \$45,026.00 and Receiver's costs of \$621.97, for a total of \$45,647.97; and

4 B. The fees of the Receiver's counsel, Barnes & Thornburg LLP  
5 of \$88,442.30 and costs of \$67.50, for a total of \$88,509.80.

6 3. Notice of the Motion is deemed sufficient under Local Rule  
7 66-7 based on the service of the Motion on all parties and certain creditors of the  
8 estate, but not on the thousands of potential consumers, lenders, loan servicers, title  
9 insurers and other third parties who may have been defrauded by the Defendants.
