ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Receiver’s, Robb Evans and Robb Evans Associates, LLC, Third Motion for Approval and Authorization for Payment of Receiver's and Professionals' Fees and Costs for the Period From May 1, 2017 Through July 31, 2018. [R. 382.] The Court, having reviewed and considered the Motion and all pleadings and papers filed in support thereof, and any responses or oppositions to the Motion and reply thereto, and good cause appearing therefor, **IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion and all relief sought therein is granted;

2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Court hereby approves and authorizes to be paid from assets of the receivership estate the Receiver's and professionals' fees and expenses incurred in the period from May 1, 2017 through and including July 31, 2018 as follows:

a. Receiver's fees of \$8,974.05 and Receiver’s costs of 4,876.11 for a total of \$13,850.16;

b. Attorneys’ fees in the amount of \$58,538.70 and costs of \$3,694.86 incurred to the Receiver’s former lead counsel, Diamond McCarthy LLP, for a total of \$62,233.56;

c. Attorneys' fees in the sum of \$29,547.90 and costs of \$698.30 incurred to the Receiver's present lead counsel, Barnes & Thornburg, LLP, for a total of \$30,246.20;

d. Attorneys' fees in the sum of \$8,776.50 and costs of \$1,554.00 incurred to the Receiver's local counsel, Wyatt Tarrant & Combs, LLP, for a total of \$10,330.50; and

e. Attorneys' fees in the amount of \$2,156.80 and costs of \$47.00 incurred to the Receiver's Florida local bankruptcy counsel, Carlton Fields, for a total of \$2,203.80.

3. Notice of the Motion is sufficient based on the service of the Motion and all supporting papers on the parties to this action, service of a Notice of Filing of the Motion on all known non-consumer, non-employee creditors of the receivership estate with the Receiver offering to provide a complete copy of the Motion to any interested party upon written request, and the Receiver's posting of the Motion and supporting pleadings, exclusive of time and billing records, on the Receiver's web site for this case.
