Order to Show Cause re
Contempt of Court

On December 10, 2018, the Court ordered Garson Silvers and Brett Wolcott to disclose to the Receiver (1) any money received from Patrick Soria or any of the Receivership Defendants since January 1, 2018; (2) any money they received as part of, or proceeds of, any transaction involving Patrick Soria or any of the Receivership Defendants since January 1, 2018; and (3) to the degree that they have knowledge, the location of any assets of Patrick Soria or any of the Receivership Defendants.

The Receiver reports that both Silvers and Wolcott have failed to comply with the Court's order. Therefore, Garson Silvers and Brett Wolcott are each ordered to show cause, in writing, no later than March 4, 2019, how they have complied with the Court's December 10, 2018 order or provide good cause for the failure to comply. Each response is to be supported by a declaration under penalty of perjury. If a respondent fails to demonstrate

compliance or good cause for the failure to comply, that respondent will be held in civil contempt and ordered to pay \$1,000 per day until the Court is satisfied that the respondent has complied or shown good cause for the failure to comply. The Court finds that \$1,000 per day is the smallest adequate amount necessary to coerce the respondents into compliance given the large sums that are potentially being hidden from the Receiver.

The Receiver is to serve this Order on Silvers and Wolcott.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
