25 California 90012, Robb Evans & Associates LLC, the Temporary Receiver for The
26 Gordon Law Firm P.C., Division One Investment and Loan, Inc., and Processing
27 Division, L.L.C., and their successors, assigns, affiliates and subsidiaries
28 (“Receivership Defendants”) pursuant to the Court’s Ex Parte Temporary

1 Restraining Order with Asset Freeze, Appointment of Temporary Receiver,
2 Expedited Discovery, and Other Equitable Relief and Order to Show Cause Why
3 Preliminary Injunction Should Not Issue entered July 18, 2012 (“TRO”) will and
4 does hereby move the Court for an order for the following relief:

5 1. For an order approving and authorizing payment of the Temporary
6 Receiver’s fees and expenses and those of its professionals incurred from the
7 inception of the receivership through and including August 31, 2012 (“Initial
8 Expense Period”) from receivership assets, including the Temporary Receiver’s
9 fees of \$219,772.69 and costs of \$7,989.40, and the Temporary Receiver’s
10 attorneys’ fees of \$26,838.45 and costs of \$325.26 incurred to its counsel,
11 McKenna Long & Aldridge LLP, for total Receiver’s and legal fees and costs
12 incurred in the Initial Expense Period of \$254,925.80;

13 2. For an order limiting notice under Local Civil Rules 66-7(f) and 6-1
14 and deeming the Temporary Receiver’s service of notice of this motion and the
15 motion on the parties to this action through service on their counsel of record,
16 service of notice of the hearing on the motion on known unpaid vendor and other
17 non-consumer creditors of the Receivership Defendants, and posting of the notice
18 of motion and motion, supporting memorandum and declarations without
19 voluminous exhibits on the Temporary Receiver’s web site for this case to be
20 sufficient and appropriate notice under the circumstances.

21 This motion is made pursuant to Local Civil Rule 66-7 and is made and
22 based on this notice of motion and motion, the accompanying memorandum of
23 points and authorities and the Declaration of Gary Owen Caris in support hereof,
24 the separate Declaration of Brick Kane in support hereof, the separate notice of
25 hearing on the motion filed concurrently herewith, on the pleadings, records and
26 files of the Court in connection with this action, including without limitation the
27 Report of Temporary Receiver’s Activities July 19, 2012 Through July 30, 2012
28 filed on August 2, 2012 (Doc. No. 28) and the Temporary Receiver’s two

1 supplemental reports, and on such other oral and documentary evidence and
2 arguments of counsel as may be presented by the Temporary Receiver prior to or at
3 the hearing on the motion.
