MEMORANDUM

This Memorandum summarizes the rulings made during the phone conference held today regarding the Receiver's Application for an Order to Show Cause Why Andris Pukke and Peter Baker should not be held in contempt.

By a separate Show Cause Order, the Court has set the date and time for the hearing as February 6, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. This Memorandum establishes the interim deadlines discussed during the phone conference.

Defense counsel is DIRECTED to file their request for production of documents by the Receiver by no later than close of business on Tuesday, November 21, 2007. The Receiver is DIRECTED to respond to said request by December 8, 2006. The Receiver shall produce copies of up to 500 pages of the documents to defense counsel in Washington, D.C. If more than 500 pages of documents are requested, the Receiver shall make the documents in excess of 500 pages available at its office in Los Angeles, California. Defense counsel shall be free to examine the documents in Los Angeles at an agreed upon time before December 8, 2006.

Defendant Andris Pukke shall make himself available for deposition by the Receiver. The parties are DIRECTED to agree on the date and time of said deposition, for up to two days during mid-December. The Court suggests December 18, 2006 and December 19, 2006 or December 19, 2006 and December 20, 2006 as the dates for said deposition, but defense counsel shall notify the Receiver of the proposed dates at the earliest possible time. Though counsel may agree on other dates, Mr. Pukke is DIRECTED to make himself available, notwithstanding any personal inconvenience.

Defense counsel will be given an opportunity to depose witnesses between January 9, 2007 and January 23, 2007.
