**ORDER ON STIPULATION TO
EXTEND TRO AND CONTINUE
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION
HEARING**

On May 13, 2008, the Court issued a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) against Defendants Helping Hands of Hope, Inc., U.S. Blind Services, Inc., Employment Opportunities of America, Inc., Third Strike Employment, Inc., and Robyn Mayhan. Pursuant to Section XXVI of the TRO, the TRO is set to expire ten court days after entry, unless Defendants consent that it may be extended for a longer period. Pursuant to Section XXV of TRO, a hearing is scheduled for May 22, 2008, at 9:00 a.m., on whether a preliminary injunction should issue against Defendants and a permanent receiver should be appointed over the corporate Defendants;


The parties have stipulated (Doc. #32) to continuing the preliminary hearing for at least three weeks to allow them additional time in which to negotiate a stipulated preliminary injunction. The parties have also stipulated to continuing the TRO until the conclusion of the preliminary injunction hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The preliminary injunction hearing is continued until June 19, 2008, at 9:00 a.m.;
2. The TRO, including the asset freeze and the appointment of the temporary receiver, shall continue in full force and effect until the conclusion of the preliminary injunction hearing;
3. The parties shall advise the Court as soon as possible if they are able to stipulate to a preliminary injunction so that the Court may take the hearing off calendar.
4. The deadline for filing the joint pleading and proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as required by the Order of May 19, 2008 (Doc. #31) is extended to June 16, 2008.
5. Defendants shall file their response in opposition to the request for a preliminary injunction and appointment of a permanent receiver by June 13, 2008.
6. Plaintiff shall file its reply to Defendants' response by June 17, 2008.
