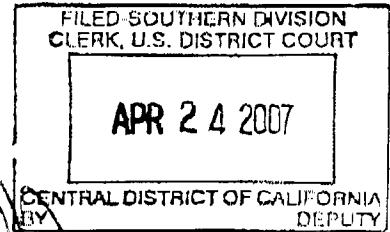

24 The Motion for Order (1) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Permanent
25 Receiver's Fees and Expenses, and for Approval and Payment of Permanent
26 Receiver's Professionals [December 1, 2006 Through February 28, 2007]; and (2)
27 Approving Limited Notice of Motion under Local Civil Rule 66-7 (the "Motion")
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1 filed by Robb Evans and Robb Evans & Associates LLC as Permanent Receiver
2 (“Receiver”) of Homeland Financial Services, Inc., National Support Services, Inc.,
3 United Debt Recovery, LLC, and Financial Liberty Services, LLC (for convenience
4 referred to herein as the “Homeland Entities”) was duly served on the interested
5 parties and scheduled for hearing at the above-referenced date, time and place. No
6 timely written opposition was filed or served. The Court, having reviewed and
7 considered the Motion and the pleadings and papers filed in support thereof and that
8 no opposition to the Motion was timely filed with the Court, having determined that
9 notice of the Motion was proper and sufficient as more particularly set forth below,
10 having taken the hearing on the Motion off calendar and having determined that the
11 Motion should be granted based upon the papers filed, and good cause appearing
12 therefor,

13 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 14 1. The Motion and the relief sought therein is granted;
- 15 2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Court hereby
16 approves and authorizes payment of the following fees and expenses incurred
17 during the period of December 1, 2006 through and including February 28, 2007
18 (“Third Expense Period”) consisting of Receiver’s fees, including those of the
19 Receiver, the Receiver’s senior members and staff, of \$23,101.74 and Receiver’s
20 expenses of \$989.93, and fees and expenses of the Receiver’s attorneys McKenna
21 Long & Aldridge LLP (“McKenna Firm”) of \$10,278.08, pertaining to the
22 receivership of the Homeland Entities.
- 23 3. Notice of the Motion is hereby deemed sufficient and appropriate
24 under the circumstances based on the Receiver’s service of notice of the Motion
25 and the Motion on the parties to this action through service on their counsel of
26 record, service of notice of the hearing on the Motion on known ^{non-}consumer creditors
27 of the Homeland Entities as well as on consumers who have affirmatively contacted
28 the Receiver for a refund, and the Receiver’s posting of the Motion, supporting

1 memorandum and declarations without voluminous exhibits on the Receiver's
2 website for this case at www.robbevans.com/html/homeland.html.
