**NOTICE OF FILING OF MOTION FOR
ORDER (1) APPROVING AND
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF
RECEIVER'S AND PROFESSIONALS'
FEES AND EXPENSES FROM AUGUST 1,
2013 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2013;
AND (2) GRANTING RELIEF FROM
LOCAL RULE 66-5 PERTAINING TO
NOTICE TO CREDITORS**

1 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Robb Evans of Robb Evans & Associates LLC
2 (“Receiver”), the Receiver pursuant to the Court’s Preliminary Injunction Order issued February
3 10, 2011, has filed his Motion for Order (1) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's
4 and Professionals' Fees and Expenses from August 1, 2013 Through November 30, 2013; and (2)
5 Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-5 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors ("Motion"). As set forth
6 in the Motion pursuant to which the Receiver moves the Court for an order for the following
7 relief:

8 1. An order approving and authorizing payment of receivership fees and expenses
9 incurred for the four-month period from August 1, 2013 through November 30, 2013 (“Expense
10 Period”), including payment of the fees of the Receiver, the Receiver’s deputies, agents, staff and
11 professionals, and reimbursement of costs incurred during the Expense Period in the total sum of
12 \$472,017.50. The fees of the Receiver, his deputies, agents and staff total \$142,216.40 and the
13 Receiver’s expenses total \$22,723.87 during the Expense Period. The Receiver’s legal fees and
14 expenses total \$307,077.23 during the Expense Period, including fees of \$279,571.50 and
15 expenses of \$15,434.90 incurred to the Receiver’s lead counsel McKenna Long & Aldridge LLP
16 for a total of \$295,006.40, expenses of the Receiver’s local counsel in Nevada, Kolesar &
17 Leatham, Chtd., in the sum of \$156.16, and fees in the amount of \$10,082.50 and expenses in the
18 amount of \$1,832.17 for services of the Receiver’s special litigation and real estate counsel in
19 Utah, Hatch, James & Dodge, P.C.; and

20 2. An order deeming notice of the Motion to be sufficient under Local Civil Rule 66-
21 5 based on the service of the notice of the filing of the Motion and the Motion on all parties and
22 service of this notice of the filing of the Motion on all known non-consumer creditors of the estate
23 concurrent with the filing of the Motion with the Court, but not the tens of thousands of potential
24 consumer creditors of the estate.

25 The Motion is made pursuant to Local Civil Rules 7-2 and 66-5 and is based upon this
26 notice of filing of the Motion, the notice of motion and motion, memorandum of points and
27 authorities and the Declarations of Brick Kane and Gary Owen Caris filed in support of the
28 Motion, the separate Appendix of Exhibits filed concurrently herewith in support of the Motion,

1 any reply, upon the pleadings, files and records of the Court in this case of which the Receiver
2 requests the Court take judicial notice, including without limitation the Report of Temporary
3 Receiver's Activities filed February 8, 2011 (Doc. No. 127) and the Report of Receiver's
4 Financial Reconstruction dated January 31, 2012 and four volumes of supporting Appendices
5 filed on February 3, 2012 (Doc. Nos. 464, 465-468), the Order Granting Motion for Order
6 Clarifying Preliminary Injunction Order and for Further Instructions Regarding Scope of
7 Receivership Defendants under Preliminary Injunction Order and Report of Receiver's Financial
8 Reconstruction and Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-5 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors After
9 Hearing ("Clarifying Order") entered March 25, 2013 and upon all other pleadings and
10 documentary evidence as may be presented to the Court by the Receiver.
