**NOTICE OF FILING OF MOTION FOR
 ORDER (1) APPROVING AND
 AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF
 RECEIVER'S AND PROFESSIONALS'
 FEES AND EXPENSES FROM
 SEPTEMBER 1, 2015 THROUGH
 DECEMBER 31, 2015; AND
 (2) GRANTING RELIEF FROM LOCAL
 RULE 66-5 PERTAINING TO NOTICE
 TO CREDITORS**

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 25 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Robb Evans of Robb Evans & Associates LLC
 26 ("Receiver"), the Receiver pursuant to the Court's Preliminary Injunction Order issued February
 27 10, 2011, has filed his Motion for Order (1) Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's
 28 and Professionals' Fees and Expenses from September 1, 2015 Through December 31, 2015; and

1 (2) Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-5 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors ("Motion"). As set
2 forth in the Motion, the Receiver moves the Court for an order for the following relief:

3 1. An order approving and authorizing payment of receivership fees and expenses
4 incurred for the four-month period from September 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015
5 ("Expense Period"), including payment of the fees of the Receiver, the Receiver's deputies,
6 agents, staff and professionals, and reimbursement of costs incurred during the Expense Period in
7 the total sum of \$237,127.93. The fees of the Receiver, his deputies, agents and staff total
8 \$44,459.38 and the Receiver's expenses total \$8,450.32 during the Expense Period. The
9 Receiver's legal fees and expenses total \$184,218.23 during the Expense Period, including fees of
10 \$175,518.90 and expenses of \$5,516.33 incurred to the Receiver's lead counsel Dentons US LLP
11 for a total of \$181,035.23, legal fees of \$262.50 and expenses of \$85.50 of the Receiver's local
12 counsel in Nevada, Kolesar & Leatham, Chtd., in the total sum of \$348.00, and fees of \$2,835.00
13 incurred for the services of the Receiver's Utah real estate counsel Nelson, Christensen,
14 Hollingworth & Williams; and

15 2. An order deeming notice of the Motion to be sufficient under Local Civil Rule 66-5
16 based on the service of the notice of the filing of the Motion and the Motion on all parties and
17 service of this notice of the filing of the Motion on all known non-consumer creditors of the estate
18 concurrent with the filing of the Motion with the Court, but not the tens of thousands of potential
19 consumer creditors of the estate.

20 The Motion is made pursuant to Local Civil Rules 7-2 and 66-5 and is based upon this
21 notice of filing of the Motion, the notice of motion and motion, memorandum of points and
22 authorities and the Declarations of Brick Kane and Gary Owen Caris filed in support of the
23 Motion, the separate Appendix of Exhibits filed concurrently herewith in support of the Motion,
24 any reply, upon the pleadings, files and records of the Court in this case of which the Receiver
25 requests the Court take judicial notice, including without limitation the Report of Temporary
26 Receiver's Activities filed February 8, 2011 (Doc. No. 127) and the Report of Receiver's
27 Financial Reconstruction dated January 31, 2012 and four volumes of supporting Appendices filed
28 on February 3, 2012 (Doc. Nos. 464, 465-468), the Order Granting Motion for Order Clarifying

1 Preliminary Injunction Order and for Further Instructions Regarding Scope of Receivership
2 Defendants under Preliminary Injunction Order and Report of Receiver's Financial Reconstruction
3 and Granting Relief from Local Rule 66-5 Pertaining to Notice to Creditors After Hearing
4 ("Clarifying Order") entered March 25, 2013 and upon all other pleadings and documentary
5 evidence as may be presented to the Court by the Receiver.
