To Contract Attorneys for UCLG:

On April 23, 2004 the Federal Trade Commission filed a lawsuit against National Consumer Council, London Financial Group, National Consumer Debt Council, LLC, Solidium, LLC, J. P. Landis, LLC, Financial Rescue Services, Inc., et al. The Federal Trade Commission has alleged that the companies violated the FTC act by Misrepresentations and Omissions and violated other Regulations and Acts.

On May 3, 2004 the United States District Court entered an Order appointing Robb Evans & Associates LLC as Temporary Receiver over all assets related to National Consumer Council, London Financial Group, National Consumer Debt Council, LLC, Solidium, LLC, J. P. Landis, LLC, Financial Rescue Services, Inc., et al.

Thereafter, on May 21, 2004, National Consumer Council, London Financial Group, National Consumer Debt Council, LLC, Solidium, LLC, J. P. Landis, LLC, Financial Rescue Services, Inc. and United Consumers Law Group, P.C., et al., each entered into a Stipulation and Preliminary Injunction for the appointment of Robb Evans & Associates LLC as Receiver and continuation of an asset freeze and other relief.

The Receiver has control of all UCLG funds and computer and other records. Pursuant to the Preliminary Injunctions entered as to all parties by the United States District Court on May 21, 2004, the businesses are now closed. You can obtain a copy of the various Court Orders on the Receiver's website at [www.ncc-receiver.com](http://www.ncc-receiver.com).

The Receiver is advised that you are now providing, or have in the past provided, legal services to various clients of the Receivership Defendants. Legal services may be in the form of debt settlement negotiations or bankruptcy actions. Approximately 70 bankruptcy filings have been transferred to independent outside counsel.

I am an attorney and a member of Robb Evans & Associates LLC, the Receiver. It is our opinion that the various Court Orders, referenced above, do not impact the attorney-client relationship you have developed with those clients referred to you by UCLG, or one of the other NCC related entities. The Receiver expects that in those cases where your fees have been prepaid in a bankruptcy case, your services will continue through completion of the bankruptcy process. In other instances where you are providing services through a reduced fee arrangement, any decision to continue legal services is between you and the respective client and will not be part of the Receivership oversight process.

Please keep in mind that the business of the Receivership Defendants has been closed. Therefore, any services relating to debt settlements, which rely upon the NCC affiliated entities to pay the settlement, have ceased and will not be available.

The Receiver has identified approximately 100 consumers who notified UCLG of their intent to file for bankruptcy protection and initiated the process by depositing funds in a UCLG trust account. It is our intention to return all documents, and remaining funds placed in the UCLG trust account, to the respective consumer.
