1 The Court has reviewed and considered the Stipulation Regarding Claims of
2 American Express Bank, FSB ("Stipulation") entered into by and between receivership
3 creditor American Express, FSB ("American Express"), by and through its counsel
4 Becket & Lee LLP; Permanent Receiver Robb Evans & Associates LLC ("Receiver"),
5 by and through its counsel of record Frandzel Robins Bloom & Csato, L.C.; Plaintiff
6 Federal Trade Commission, by and through its counsel; and all Defendants who have
